Scriptural

scruple

(n) Doubt or uncertainty regarding a

scrupulous

(adj) Cautious in action for fear of
doing wrong.

scurrilous

(adj) Grossly indecent or vulgar.

scuttle

(v) To sink (a ship) by making holes in the bottom.

scythe

(n) A long curved blade for mowing, reaping, etc.

séance

(n) A meeting of spirituals for consulting spirits.

sear

(v) To burn on the surface.
